- We will comply with all relevant legislation, regulation and industry codes of practice through effective deployment of our health and safety management systems.
- All incidents must be reported, investigated and where required, remedial actions will be taken to avoid repeats.
- McLeod Aggregates Ltd is a company which cares for its employees and they in turn must care for each other.
- No task is so important that it cannot be done safely.
- Ensure all hazards are identified and that risks are assessed and eliminated where practicable.
- Where a task is deemed 'high risk' through risk assessment, outside contractors or help will be sought.
- Safety (Zero LTIs) – Zero LTIs for both employees and contractors.
